Mayor Hancock --

We are writing in response to the below February 28 email from April Villa regarding the Park Hill Golf Course (PHGC) land.

We are unaware of any pending litigation regarding the PHGC land in which the city is a party. If such a lawsuit exists, please advise us immediately of its case caption and case number.

Assuming that there is no such pending lawsuit, there is no legitimate basis for you to decline responding fully to the candidate questionnaire. Based upon your declination to participate as well as the language contained in the second paragraph of Ms. Villa's email, our publicity regarding the results of the candidate questionnaire will report that you do not support either preservation of the PHGC perpetual open space conservation easement or potential acquisition by the city of the PHGC land for designation as a city park unless we hear from you to the contrary no later than March 8, 2019.
