On June 2, 2021 this office received 189 petition sections for a proposed initiated ordinance, the Park and Open Space Preservation Initiated Ordinance. Pursuant to Denver Clerk and Recorder Election Rule 5.8, a review of the petition sections you submitted indicates the following:

In accordance with Denver Clerk and Recorder Election Rule 5.9.1, you are hereby notified that the Denver Elections Division has determined that the petition contains a sufficient number of valid signatures to place the measure on the ballot for the November 2, 2021 Coordinated Election.

As of the date of this letter, there have been no protests filed. If no protests are filed by 5:00 p.m., June 28, 2021,ⁱ the Denver Elections Division will notify the Denver City Council of this sufficiency decision by providing a copy of this letter to the President of the Denver City Council. Unless the City Council calls for a special election to submit the measure to the voters, the Clerk and Recorder will submit the initiated ordinance to the ballot at the next scheduled citywide election, the November 2, 2021 Coordinated Election.
